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p. 365: The Barrett Family:

"In 1777 Samuel was under Capt. Marcus Moseman, his uncle. Capt. Hezekiah Gray was killed and his wife and 4 children managed a tavern across the road from Samuel's house. In 1778 Samuel married the widow Abigail (Waterbury) Gray (1743-1805) daughter of David and Mary (Sturges) Waterbury."
