An Insane Farmer Knocks His Son-in-Law Down and Kills Himself.

JACKSON, December 5.--(Special.)--A shocking tragedy occurred in the Township of Springport, this county, yesterday. John Rough, aged 30, lived on a farm owned by his father-in-law, Doremus Dodd. Dodd has for some time been thought to be insane and there has been talk of sending him to the asylum at Kalamazoo. Lately Dodd imagined that Rough was not doing as well by him as he should and urged him to move off the farm. This was not thought advisable by his friends, and when yesterday Dodd renewed his demand Rough tried to persuade him to give up the idea and let him remain. This enraged Dodd and he struck Rough several times on the head with his cane, causing several severe scalp wounds and knocking him insensible. Dodd then rushed home and seizing a razor cut his own throat, completely severing the windpipe. Death resulted a few hours later. Considerable excitement is caused in the community as both men were highly respected. Dodd was 60 years of age and leaves a widow and nine children.



"Everyone liked 'Pete" and there was probably not a man in the community that would have been missed more. Beside the numerous relatives, friends and neighbors, the township will feel his loss keenly. He has been highway commissioner for years and has had charge of the building of nearly all the excellent roads for which this township is famous throughout Michigan. He knew where any gravel could be found in the township and though he did not claim to be an expert, his estimate on the cost of a proposed road was generally nearer right than that of state or county officers."

"The I.O.O.F., Rebekahs and W.R.C. attended the funeral in a body and the Odd Fellows were in charge of the burial services. Rev. Steffe of Burr Oak, assisted by Rev. Williams, preached the funeral sermon."

The many floral offerings attested in a way the esteem in which the deceased was held. Besides numerous pieces from relatives and personal friends, beautiful pieces were sent by the I.O.O.F., W.R.C., Needlecraft Club, Baptist Church, Firemen, Friends and business men, Fellow road men and Town board."

"Peter, son of John and Harriet Orrison, was born in New Chambersburg, Columbiana, Co. Ohio, May 17, 1864, and died Oct. 11th, 1916. At the age of three years his parents came to Michigan and resided three miles north of Springport.

At the age of 24 years he was united in marriage to Louesa Dodd. To this union two sons were born - Jesse of Jackson and Harold, now at Columbus (OH).

Beside the widow and sons he leaves a father, and two sisters to mourn their loss, together with a host of other relatives and friends."

Louesa next married **Harvey J. Allen**, son of **William P. Allen** and **Mary Dyer**, on Oct 25, 1918. Harvey was born in 1855 in New York and died in Apr 1928 at age 73.


